



London Mavericks Activities, Camps, Tournaments and Trial Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to all London Mavericks activities, including but not limited to camps, coaching sessions, workshops, clinics, masterclasses, tournaments, competitions, festivals, pathway programmes, training sessions and trials (“Activities”).

By booking, entering, registering for, or attending an Activity, the participant and/or their parent/guardian agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

1. Bookings, Entries and Payment

1.1 All bookings, entries and registrations must be completed through the official London Mavericks booking platform or any other official method communicated by London Mavericks.

1.2 Full payment must be received at the time of booking in order to secure a place, entry or team space.

1.3 A booking confirmation email constitutes acceptance of the booking by London Mavericks.

1.4 London Mavericks reserves the right to refuse or cancel any booking, entry or registration at its discretion, including where eligibility requirements are not met, incorrect information has been provided, or participation may present a welfare, safeguarding, behavioural, operational or health and safety concern.

1.5 For tournaments or competitions, team entries are only confirmed once payment has been received and confirmation has been issued by London Mavericks.

2. Refunds, Cancellations and Transfers

2.1 All bookings, entries and registrations are final, subject to any statutory rights that cannot legally be excluded.

2.2 Once a booking has been completed and payment received, London Mavericks is not obliged to provide refunds, credits, transfers or exchanges where the participant or team cancels, withdraws, fails to attend, or is unable to participate, including but not limited to:

- illness or injury;
- participant or team withdrawal;

- inability to attend;
- change in personal circumstances;
- transport disruption;
- adverse weather conditions where the Activity continues to operate;
- dissatisfaction with tournament results, playing time, grading, fixtures, umpiring decisions, trial outcomes or selection decisions.

2.3 Failure to attend an Activity, tournament or trial for any reason will be treated as a cancellation by the participant or team.

2.4 London Mavericks is under no obligation to provide alternative sessions, tournament places, fixtures or trial opportunities for missed Activities.

2.5 Where London Mavericks is able, at its sole discretion, to fill a cancelled place or team entry, it may choose to offer a partial credit, transfer or refund after deducting reasonable administration costs and any costs already incurred.

2.6 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions affects any legal rights a participant, parent/guardian or team may have where London Mavericks cancels an Activity entirely, fails to provide the Activity, or where liability cannot legally be excluded.

3. Trials and Selection

3.1 Attendance at a London Mavericks trial does not guarantee selection into any squad, programme, pathway, academy, team, tournament squad, competition squad or future opportunity.

3.2 All participants will be assessed against criteria determined by London Mavericks coaching and performance staff. Selection decisions may take into account multiple factors including, but not limited to:

- technical ability;
- tactical understanding;
- athletic performance;
- positional balance;
- attitude and behaviour;
- athlete potential;
- squad requirements;
- long-term pathway considerations;

- competition or tournament requirements.

3.3 All selection decisions made by London Mavericks selectors, coaches and staff are final.

3.4 Due to the volume of trial applicants and participants, London Mavericks is unable to provide individual feedback to unsuccessful trialists unless expressly stated otherwise in advance.

3.5 London Mavericks will not enter into correspondence, appeals, disputes or discussions regarding selection decisions once they have been communicated.

3.6 London Mavericks reserves the right not to fill all available places within a programme, squad, tournament squad or competition squad if selectors determine that the required standard has not been met.

3.7 London Mavericks reserves the right to offer places, reserve places, guest places, invite-only places or additional assessment opportunities at its sole discretion.

3.8 Selection into a programme, team, tournament squad or competition squad does not guarantee future selection, match play, court time, tournament entry, competition opportunities or progression within the London Mavericks pathway.

3.9 Trial dates, venues, formats, assessors and schedules may be amended where reasonably necessary.

3.10 Participants are responsible for ensuring they meet any published eligibility requirements prior to booking.

3.11 Any participant found to have provided false, misleading or inaccurate information during the registration process may have their trial place, tournament place, programme place or offer withdrawn without refund, subject to any statutory rights that cannot legally be excluded.

4. Tournaments, Competitions and Fixtures

4.1 London Mavericks may organise, host or participate in tournaments, competitions, festivals, match play events or similar competitive activities.

4.2 Tournament formats, fixtures, divisions, age groups, rules, timings, venues, court allocations and schedules may be amended where reasonably necessary.

4.3 London Mavericks does not guarantee any specific number of fixtures, playing time, court time, opposition standard, competition outcome or progression route unless expressly stated in writing.

4.4 Participants, teams, coaches, spectators and parents/guardians must comply with all tournament rules, venue rules, codes of conduct, safeguarding requirements, umpire instructions and London Mavericks staff instructions.

4.5 Umpiring, scoring, grading, disciplinary and competition decisions made by appointed officials, organisers or London Mavericks staff are final.

4.6 London Mavericks reserves the right to remove, disqualify or refuse participation to any participant, team, coach, spectator or parent/guardian whose behaviour is considered unsafe, abusive, discriminatory, disruptive, inappropriate or contrary to the values of London Mavericks.

4.7 Removal or disqualification from a tournament or competition for behavioural, eligibility, safeguarding or disciplinary reasons will not entitle the participant or team to a refund or compensation, subject to any statutory rights that cannot legally be excluded.

4.8 Teams are responsible for ensuring that all players are eligible, appropriately registered, medically fit and properly supervised.

4.9 London Mavericks accepts no responsibility for a team's failure to provide the required number of players, appropriately qualified coaches, responsible adults, kit, equipment or documentation.

5. Changes, Postponements and Cancellation by London Mavericks

5.1 London Mavericks reserves the right to amend schedules, venues, coaches, session content, tournament formats, fixture lists, rules, groupings, timings or Activity formats where reasonably necessary.

5.2 London Mavericks reserves the right to postpone, reschedule or cancel an Activity due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to:

- adverse weather;
- facility issues;
- health and safety concerns;
- staff illness;
- insufficient participant or team numbers;
- safeguarding concerns;
- force majeure events;
- venue closures;
- changes required by a governing body, venue provider or local authority.

5.3 Where London Mavericks cancels an Activity entirely and does not provide a reasonable alternative, London Mavericks will consider an appropriate refund, partial refund or account credit, taking into account the circumstances, costs already incurred and any legal rights that apply.

5.4 Where an Activity, tournament or fixture is postponed or rescheduled, London Mavericks may offer an alternative date, venue or format. If a participant or team cannot attend the rearranged date, this will be treated in accordance with the cancellation provisions set out in these Terms and Conditions and any applicable statutory rights.

6. Medical Information and Participant Welfare

6.1 The participant and/or parent/guardian is responsible for providing accurate and complete medical, emergency contact and welfare information at the time of booking.

6.2 Participants must be physically fit and able to safely take part in the Activity.

6.3 London Mavericks reserves the right to refuse participation where medical, behavioural, safeguarding or welfare concerns may place the participant or others at risk.

6.4 In the event of illness or injury, London Mavericks staff may administer basic first aid and seek emergency medical treatment where necessary.

6.5 Participants must bring any required medication with them to the Activity, including inhalers, EpiPens or other prescribed medication.

6.6 For tournaments and team events, team organisers, coaches and parents/guardians remain responsible for ensuring that relevant medical and welfare information is available and shared appropriately.

7. Behaviour and Conduct

7.1 Participants, parents/guardians, coaches, team officials and spectators are expected to behave respectfully towards staff, coaches, officials, umpires, venue staff, facilities and other participants at all times.

7.2 Bullying, abusive language, discrimination, aggressive behaviour, harassment, intimidation, poor sportsmanship or conduct deemed unsafe or inappropriate will not be tolerated.

7.3 London Mavericks reserves the right to remove any participant, team, parent/guardian, coach, official or spectator whose behaviour is considered unsafe, disruptive, abusive, discriminatory or inappropriate.

7.4 Removal from an Activity for behavioural reasons will not entitle the participant or team to any refund or compensation, subject to any statutory rights that cannot legally be excluded.

8. Photography and Media

8.1 London Mavericks may photograph or film Activities for coaching, safeguarding, promotional, marketing, website and social media purposes.

8.2 By attending an Activity, participants and/or parents/guardians consent to the use of such images and recordings unless written notice is provided to London Mavericks in advance of the Activity.

8.3 For tournaments, team organisers are responsible for ensuring that parents/guardians of all participants are aware of any photography and filming arrangements.

8.4 London Mavericks may restrict photography or filming where safeguarding, welfare or venue requirements make this necessary.

9. Injury, Risk and Insurance

9.1 Participation in Activities involves inherent sporting risks, including the risk of injury.

9.2 Participants take part at their own risk, except where injury, loss or damage is caused by the negligence of London Mavericks or where liability cannot legally be excluded.

9.3 London Mavericks recommends that all participants and teams have appropriate personal accident, medical, travel and/or team insurance in place prior to attendance.

9.4 London Mavericks shall not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage sustained except where caused by proven negligence or where liability cannot legally be excluded.

10. Parent, Guardian and Team Responsibility

10.1 Parents/guardians remain responsible for participants before the Activity starts and immediately after it finishes, including supervision during drop-off and collection.

10.2 London Mavericks accepts no responsibility for participants outside advertised session times.

10.3 Parents/guardians must ensure emergency contact details remain accurate and up to date.

10.4 For tournaments and team events, team organisers, coaches and responsible adults remain responsible for the supervision, conduct and welfare of their players and associated spectators unless expressly agreed otherwise in writing.

11. Late Collection

11.1 Participants must be collected promptly at the stated finish time.

11.2 London Mavericks reserves the right to charge reasonable additional costs incurred as a result of persistent late collection.

11.3 Where late collection creates a safeguarding or welfare concern, London Mavericks may take appropriate action in line with its safeguarding procedures.

12. Kit, Equipment and Personal Property

12.1 Participants are responsible for bringing appropriate clothing, footwear, fluids, food, medication and equipment required for the Activity.

12.2 For tournaments, participants and teams are responsible for ensuring they have suitable match kit, bibs, balls, first aid supplies and any other required equipment unless London Mavericks expressly states otherwise.

12.3 All personal belongings are brought at the participant's own risk.

12.4 London Mavericks accepts no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged property, except where caused by the negligence of London Mavericks or where liability cannot legally be excluded.

13. Health and Safety Compliance

13.1 Participants, parents/guardians, coaches, team officials and spectators must follow all instructions provided by London Mavericks staff, coaches, venue staff, umpires, officials and event organisers.

13.2 London Mavericks reserves the right to refuse participation or remove individuals where health and safety requirements are not complied with.

13.3 Participants must not attend or continue to participate where they are unwell, injured, medically unfit, or otherwise unable to safely take part.

14. Force Majeure

14.1 London Mavericks shall not be liable for any failure or delay in performing its obligations where such failure or delay results from events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to severe weather, strikes, pandemics, government restrictions, power failures, transport disruption, venue closures, public health restrictions, acts of terrorism, civil unrest, or other events outside London Mavericks' reasonable control.

14.2 Where a force majeure event affects an Activity, London Mavericks will act reasonably in deciding whether to continue, postpone, amend, reschedule or cancel the Activity.

15. Use of Third-Party Venues

15.1 Some Activities may take place at third-party facilities. Participants, parents/guardians, coaches, team officials and spectators must comply with all venue rules, regulations and codes of conduct.

15.2 London Mavericks accepts no liability for acts or omissions of third-party venue providers, except where liability cannot legally be excluded.

15.3 London Mavericks may be required to share relevant participant, team, safeguarding, welfare or operational information with venue providers where reasonably necessary for the delivery of the Activity.

16. Limitation of Liability

16.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, London Mavericks shall not be liable for:

- loss, theft or damage to personal belongings;
- indirect or consequential losses;
- cancellation costs incurred by participants, parents/guardians, teams or spectators;
- travel, accommodation or other expenses incurred in connection with an Activity;
- injuries sustained during participation except where caused by the negligence of London Mavericks.

16.2 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud, fraudulent misrepresentation, breach of statutory rights, or any other liability which cannot legally be excluded under English law.

17. Data Protection and Mailing List

17.1 Personal information provided during booking, registration or entry will be processed in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation and the London Mavericks Privacy Policy.

17.2 London Mavericks may use participant and team information for the purposes of administering bookings, delivering Activities, managing welfare and safeguarding, communicating with participants and parents/guardians, and complying with legal or regulatory obligations.

17.3 When booking, registering for, entering or joining a London Mavericks Activity, programme, camp, trial, tournament or competition, participants and/or parents/guardians may be added to the London Mavericks mailing list to receive

information about London Mavericks activities, programmes, events, trials, tournaments, offers, news and related opportunities.

17.4 Participants and/or parents/guardians will be given a clear opportunity to opt out of marketing communications at the time their details are collected and may unsubscribe or opt out at any time using the unsubscribe link in any marketing email or by contacting London Mavericks.

17.5 London Mavericks will not sell personal information to third parties.

18. Safeguarding

18.1 London Mavericks is committed to providing a safe and positive environment for all participants.

18.2 Any safeguarding concerns arising before, during or after an Activity may be managed in accordance with London Mavericks' safeguarding policies and procedures.

18.3 London Mavericks reserves the right to refuse or remove participation where safeguarding concerns arise.

19. Governing Law

19.1 These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

19.2 Any disputes arising in connection with these Terms and Conditions shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
